Snowmobile Council will continue to honor the previously conducted vote to keep the Oneida County Snowmobile Trails closed due to poor snow conditions.

As the custodians of the trail system, both on public and private lands, we understand the privilege it is to use these trails and do not want to abuse that privilege and/or risk rider safety.

The Oneida County Snowmobile Council will review the trail opening decision as soon as conditions change."

Oneida County has approximately 800 miles of public snowmobile trails, some state funded and others club-funded. The state-funded, county-sponsored trails are maintained by the Oneida County Snowmobile Council. There are also numerous road routes available. Official dates of trail opening and closing are published in the Oneida County newspaper and on the County government website.
